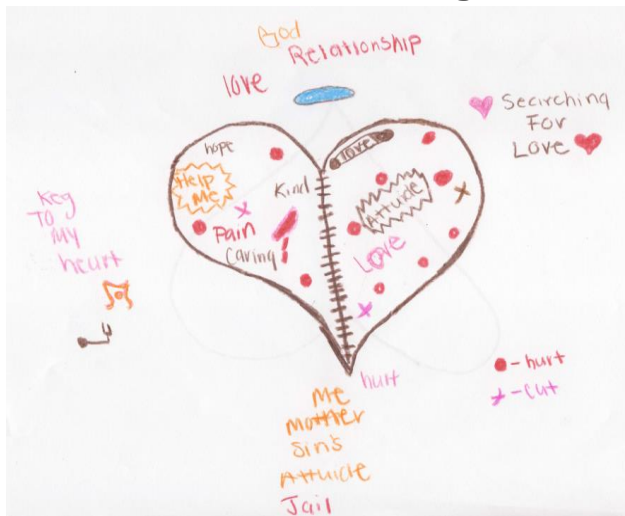

JUVENILE JAIL & PRISON MINISTRY
