When we met her in July, she was living in an upstairs apartment in a warehouse building in the Donaldson Center. While we waited five months for the Department of Social Services (DSS) to give us the okay on her background check, your contributions paid for her driver’s training course. We are happy to report that she got her license! We also assisted her in getting into the Goodwill Job Connection program. Through that program, she received her GED, on-the-job training and educational assistance. They’re sponsoring her tuition for Medical Coding at Greenville Tech starting January 2018! At home, we’re building a trusting family relationship, which is tough at age 19 when you’ve had to do most everything on your own. We’re also working on life and independent living skills and teaching her how to take care of her car. We’re blessed to participate with Jesus in the restoration of this young lady. Please continue to pray for our family, as the Lord continues to expand our borders.
